- POSITIVE attitude attitude is everything!
 - o If existing volunteers are positive and can share the benefits of volunteering they feel, it can attract others to do the same
 - Good communication and 'story telling' about what volunteering does for existing volunteers and the community
- Understanding that each generation has a different perspective on 'recognition':
 - The younger demographic typically loves recognition
 - Others may not
 - We need to be flexible to come up with a program that isn't one size fits all
- Connection is everything!
 - We need to find an easy way to contact residents in the areas of our community associations
 - We need to 'survey' our connections and our residents to find out what it is that they like to do and want to do
 - o Is there a program or a system that we can all use to be more efficient?
