Material & Labour estimate for insulating Kitchen Dennis Hobman has estimated the cost of materials for the reno at approximately \$2,075 plus labour (he charges \$35 per hour); the labour will be approximately 144 hours including electrical (probably less if the west wall is to be insulated on the outside); the cost of electrical will be approximately \$2,500.
